Vidya Dham Samiti has turned 19 this year.


In 2001 when we began, we were a small group of like-minded youth who strongly felt that we should work for the betterment of the marginalized people in the poor areas of Bundelkhand. Today if we look back, 19 years seems like a very small period, there is still so much to be done and to be learnt from. For an organization working on the most neglected issues of the marginalized communities who are themselves often unnoticed, the experience has been humbling for all of us.

In 2005 we started a community social group called Chingari Saghthan. Today, more than 10000 women from over 50 villages are part of the Sanghthan. We have been trying to empower the women and youth to claim their rights, stand up for each other, raise their voice towards the developmental issues of the village, educate one another and volunteer to preserve the natural resources. The leaders of Chingari are the real torch-bearers of the initiatives.

We are writing this report to share some important information and some powerful pictures; we want to depict the power of the so called powerless through these words and pictures.

Our Reach

Vidya Dham Samiti is working in three districts of Uttar Pradesh namely Banda, Chitrakoot and Mahoba. In these districts there are 6 Blocks and 74 villages where VDS is working on multiple issues such as rights and entitlements of the marginalized, health, education and empowerment of the woman. Woman, Tribal, Dalit and marginalized youth are in the forefront of the initiatives taken by the organization. We believe in empowering people by making them aware about their rights so that they can assert for their rights as dignified citizens.





Satyagraha to stop illegal sand mining in Ken River

In November 2019 private owners of mines illegally grabbed the land of farmers for mining. Villagers of Bariyari became furious seeing mining being done in their land. The livelihoods of many farmers were dependent on the land. The villagers were also concerned about the environmental damage that the mining would cause. From first week of November hundreds of villagers started Jal Satyagraha, they stood in the river bank throughout the day and night. The villagers also reached out to the local authorities with the issue. They continued the Satyagraha for more than 3 days before getting the mining stopped.



Efforts by the community brings electricity in the village

In Narsinghpur village of Banda people were living in extremely difficult circumstances. Till 2019 electricity was not there in the village causing it difficult for children to study, doing the daily chores and stepping out of the homes at night, especially for women. Despite several attempts residents could not get the authorities to work on this issue. In May 2019 the community jointly decided to reach out to the higher authorities at the district level with this issue. This time they were determined to get electricity in the village. Local media was also contacted to publicize the issue. Eventually after a week of struggle the project was finally sanctioned. Today, all the houses in the village have electricity opening the doors to a number of other developmental possibilities.



Tribals claim Land Rights after decades of being landless

In the Dafai village of Akbarpur Gram Panchayat, Chitrakoot district people are living in extremely difficult circumstance. A visit to the village would make one witness that the community does not even have the most basic amenities such as food, water, shelter to live a dignified life. The land on which they have made their temporary shelter belongs to a rich landlord who also owns the mines and make these people work as bonded labourers. The community jointly campaigned in front of SDM office. They made a sustained effort to get their voice heard by the concerned authorities. The scale of illiteracy and unawareness in the village was quite high that it took almost a year for the community leaders to prepare the people so that they can fearlessly claim their rights in the face of all exploitations.



Breaking the everyday patriarchal norms that deprive woman

It is common to see woman in Bundelkhand being confined to their homes in Purdha (Veil) and not having space to express themselves. Many of them suffer from domestic violence as well as caste and class based violence on a day to day basis. Afraid of the orthodox social norms and being socially ostracised they suffer in silence. The organisation is empowering woman to assert their voice for themselves and for each other. The Chingari Saghthan plays a crucial role in reducing the cases of violence, alcoholism and abuse. Over the years such efforts have had a huge impact on the lives of women.





Chingari Chaupal

The Chingari Chaupal works as a local platform and help centre for many-fold issues concerning violence and injustice on women. These Chaupals are held every Sunday at the head office of Vidya Dham Samiti. Local social workers, legal experts, community leaders, people seeking help take part in the event. The cases are heard and understood by the local experts, opinions are sought on measures that should be taken to ensure justice to the complainant and the victim of the cases of violence are made to feel safe and supported. Over the years Chingari Chapual has become an important platform for people seeking justice, the event has gained popularity in the region as "the voice of the voiceless".





Rights and Entitlement Workshop

Rights and Entitlement workshops are held once in three months. In these workshops the participants were informed about different entitlement schemes that are being implemented by the government such as Housing allowance (Awas Yojana), Public Distribution system (PDS), Old age pension, MNREGA, health and education related schemes, etc. The workshop covered the basic information about the schemes such as eligible beneficiaries, procedure to submit applications, the government departments and officials concerned with different schemes etc. As an outcome of these workshops a number of people from different villages came forward to submit the application seeking entitlements. The leaders also raised voice for community entitlements such as Aanganwadi centres, constructions of hand pump, road etc. Such workshops play an important role in empowering people.



A woman fought against corrupt government officials to get her housing allowance sanctioned



Kunti a Dalit women from Kachhiya purwa village of Narini Block fought for the sake of her rights. Despite her name being part of the AWAS YOJANA (Housing Allowance) she was asked to pay 20,000 rupees by the Block Development Officer in order to get her housing allowance sanctioned. she denied paying bribe for the same her name was kept out of the list and she was denied any housing allowance. Kunti raised this issue in one of the meetings of the Chingari Sanghatan. The leaders of the Sanghthan guided her to write a complaint against the BDO. Kunti wrote a complaint and fearlessly fought for her right. As an outcome the BDO was scrutinized and was asked to give Kunta her allowance as per the scheme. She received an apology from the BDO and her housing allowance was paid in the stipulated time.



A Sanghthan leader known for his commitment and Hard work



Once upon a time, around 10 years from now Bhawarpur village was considered to be one of the most backward villages of the region. Many residents of this village had migrated to cities for work. Villagers were not getting the benefit of entitlement schemes such as PDS, MNREGA, Pension etc. Ramsajeevan played a pivotal role in making people aware about the different entitlement schemes. Many people could get MNREGA jobs after the lockdown because of the efforts made by Ramsajeevan. Villagers could also avail the benfit of other entitlements because of advocacy done by him.



A Case of Caste Discrimination

In Punahur village of Visanda Block a community gathering was held in temple in January 2020. In this event a typical case of caste discrimination emerged. The Dalits were not allowed to take part in the event and neither were they served food. This incident came to notice of VDS field staff Suresh Kuswhwaha. He organized a meeting with the community members, village heads, upper caste in the presence of SDM and discussed about the consequence of such discrimination and about the human rights violence. Another event was organized by the upper castes in which Dalits were respectfully invited and severed food which marked the end of caste discrimination in the village.
